NRCS Report: Kyle Lunsford extended thank you for fridge/microwave, patience with office reorganization and LWG participation. They have 93 EQIP apps with 67 of them being Bonner Co. with 10-15 of them projected to cancel/ineligible based on historical. Most of the forestry contracts south of lake will be Joint chiefs, and IRA. CSP (Conservation Stewardship Program) can be used for smaller acreage and second sign-up through April 5<sup>th</sup>. Potential on Boyer Slough Project plans to work with Jenna to identify. Discussed Conservation Team 1 Townhall meeting Jan 11 at SAOC.

### Pack River Watershed Council - Jessica Erickson:

<u>SWC Report – Jenna D. and Bill L.:</u> District Performance report due Dec. 20<sup>th</sup>. There will be 3 new staff members joining their team in the next couple of months.

WQPA- Project has been completed went fairly well. There was a delay due to having to build an access road. The willows were buried a bit more then desired, will reevaluate and watch trees. It will take the Willows approx. 2-3 years to see full potential. The Planting was a challenge due to the sand.
