# **AGENCY REPORTS**

- 1. NRCS Report Cindy Lewis: Nick will be moving out to another position. The position will become open. Hope it will not be vacant long. Admin position interviews this week. This position will allow for the planners to focus on technical assistance and like their jobs.
- 2. Lakes Commission- Molly not present Discussion was had regarding issue at the Albeni Falls Dam was identified when metal fragments were discovered. All dams are being inspected to before Lake Pend Oreille water level is fully raised, looking at end of June.
- 3. Water Festival: Setup is Tuesday and in class sessions are wrapping up.
- 4. SWC Report Jenna Ditzel: Basic overview of grant submittal dates.
- 5. GOSC- Austin Terrell: There has been zero conflicts of grizzly bears. Governor office received HB592 funding which \$75K is for bear compensation such as fencing, and \$150K is reserved for livestock depredation. Outreach activities are the NW Hunt Fest, Bear Fair on Sept 28th at Bonners Ferry fairgrounds. The carcass Pick-up Program so far has collected 12 animals this year.
- 6. Bonner County Weed Department- Chase Youngdahl: Idaho registration rule has been approved/updated for noxious weed and pesticides. Noxious weed Buffalo Weed has been dropped and Japanese Blood grass was added. Spraying of noxious weeds start late June-August. You can go on the website to get special forms and sign for no spray.
- 7. AIS/Boat Stations- Sarah & Tom Fleer: All stations are now open 16hrs a day, 0530 to 2100 hours. So far this year around 620 inspections. No infested boats so far. A Sagle bound boat was found with mussels at a MT inspection station. The vessel is currently being cleaned and

detailed. Mussels were most likely dead since boat has been out of water for more than 30 days. Department of Ag. is working with the boat owner. The final inspection/decontamination will be this Friday at Albeni Station. IDSA crew will inspect and hot was as needed.

All station supervisors and three new employees are at a training today in Coeur d'Alene for hands-on hot washing experience. Since the last board meeting, we hired three new employees; two at Clark Fork and one at Samuels. All openings were created when current employees had to quit due to personal or family issues.
